



Corrected Information about the Magnus Health Portal & Required Health Forms

Recently, you received a letter from Principia College's Dean of Students with information about pre-Welcome Week requirements.

Please note: we are working to ensure that your Principia email will receive login instructions to the Magnus Health portal by the middle of next week (the week of July 23, 2023).

PLEASE CAREFULLY REVIEW THIS CORRECTED INFORMATION, which appears below in boldface, regarding immunizations:

Immunization records required by the State of Illinois include:

- Tetanus - Students shall provide dates of any combination of three or more doses of Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis containing vaccine. One dose must be Tdap vaccine. The last dose of vaccine (DTP, DTaP, DT, Td, or Tdap) must have been received within 10 years prior to the term of current enrollment;
- **Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) - Students shall provide documentation of receipt of two doses on or after the first birthday. The minimum time interval between each dose must have been at least four weeks (28 days). Students who cannot provide proof of immunization may provide laboratory (serologic) evidence of immunity.**
- Meningococcal (MCV) – Beginning Fall term 2016-2017, all new admissions under the age of 22 shall show proof of having at least one dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine on or after 16 years of age.
- All international students are also required to submit either proof of TB vaccination, or TB test results from within the last six months.
